<p>BIKES ON BUSES</p>	<p><u>NAPA COUNTY:</u> <u>The VINE:</u> All buses are equipped with front-mounted bicycle racks that carry two bikes. <u>Yountville Shuttle:</u> All buses are equipped with front-mounted bicycle racks that carry two bikes. <u>SOLANO COUNTY:</u> <u>Benicia Breeze:</u> All buses are equipped with bike racks that carry two bikes. If full, additional bikes may be stored on the bus on a space-available basis. <u>Fairfield/Suisun Transit:</u> All local buses are equipped with front-mounted bicycle racks that carry two bikes. SolanoExpress buses (Route 20, Route 30, Route 40 and Route 90) have racks that carry two bikes. If full, additional bikes may be stored on the bus on a space-available basis. <u>Rio Vista Delta Breeze:</u> All buses are equipped with bike racks that carry two bikes. If full, additional bikes may be stored on the bus on a space-available basis. <u>Vacaville City Coach:</u> All buses are equipped with bike racks that carry two bikes. If full, additional bikes may be stored on the bus on a space-available basis. <u>Vallejo Transit:</u> All buses are equipped with bike racks that carry two bikes. If full, additional bikes can be stored on the bus at the discretion of the driver. Intercity buses cannot accommodate more than two bikes. <u>Yolobus:</u> All buses are equipped with special racks; almost any kind of bike can be secured to the front of the bus. No bikes allowed on bus. For complete policy including loading/unloading instructions, call (800) 535-6883.</p>			
<p>BIKES ON RAIL</p>	<p><u>BART:</u> Bikes are allowed on all trains except those trains in the highlighted areas of the BART schedules published in the BART Fares and Schedules brochure. (Bikes are primarily restricted during commute hours in peak commute locations.) Bicyclists are responsible for checking the schedule. Bikes are not allowed in the first car of a train and are only allowed in the rear of the cars. Bicyclists under the age of 14 years old must be accompanied by an adult. At BART stations, bikes must be parked in racks and lockers. Call (510) 464-7133 for locker availability. <u>AMTRAK:</u> Bikes may be carried onto Capitol Corridor trains at no extra charge. Three bike slots are available on a first-come, first-serve basis in the bi-level California cars. A copy of AMTRAK's own Bicycle Policy is available from Solano Napa Commuter Information to carry with you if needed. Call (800) 535-6883 for a copy of the policy. On connecting AMTRAK buses to San Francisco, bikes may be placed in the luggage compartment.</p>			
<p>BIKES ON THE VALLEJO FERRY</p>	<p>The <i>SOLANO</i>, <i>INTINTOLI</i> and <i>MARE ISLAND</i> ferries can carry up to 25 bikes outside on the main deck. All ferries allow bikes on board unless conditions or passenger loads preclude the safe transport of bikes.</p>
