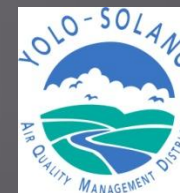

Employer Program Highlights

State Compensation Insurance Fund (State Fund)

- Coordination meetings w/ State Fund in Vacaville
- Employee survey – 450 completed surveys
- Ridematch (carpool/vanpool) and transit options
- Hosted 2 events (Vacaville and San Francisco) – 525 employees attended
- Vanpool formation support – 1 on the road July 1; 8 more formed since
